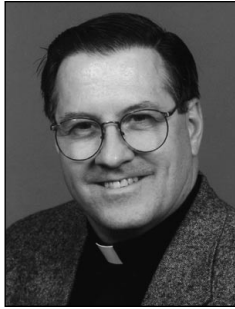


Dear Friend,

- Seek to help carry out the Great Commission.

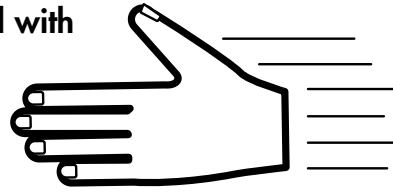
The AALC stresses:

- The sacredness of all human life.

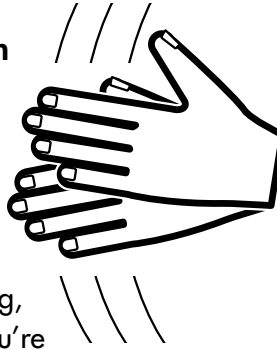
CAUTION:

Before you visit Calvary, you may want to practice this conditioning exercise:

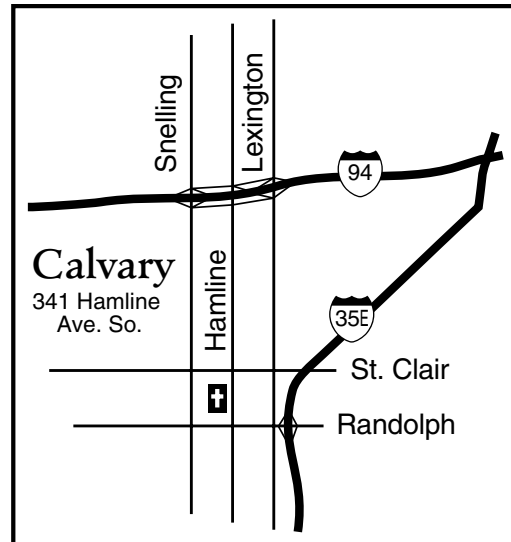
1. Extend Hand with Enthusiasm.



2. Shake Up and Down Vigorously.

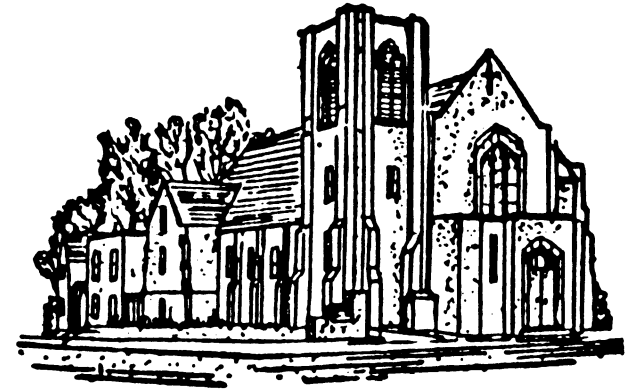

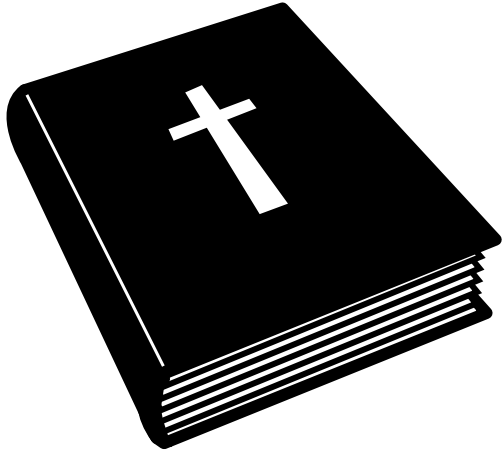

— PRAISE —

— PRAYER —
